## 17.07. - 31.08.2016 - SuSy Support System

My name is Nadja Grossenbacher and I had the pleasure of working as an intern in the frame of the ImPulsTanz-Festival in Vienna in the summer of 2016. The SuSy - internship is an activity of danceWEB, co-ordinator of the project Life Long Burning.

Basically my job consisted of Production Assistance. My main responsibilities were to prepare and deliver fruits to the artists, design and print the invitations for the reception at the festival-lounge and to prepare the welcome-bags for all the artists who arrived in Vienna during the whole period of the festival.

Preparing the welcome-bags also meant to make a plan of how to actually get them to the according people – mostly they were given to the drivers but sometimes I also took them to their accommodation, which turned out very convenient as they were located literally around the corner – therefore I was happy to pass by on my way home in the evening.

However there was sort of a special focus on the 8:tension artists – all the 8:tension artists received a T-Shirt of their choice as well as wristbands which give them access to the festival tent.

Concerning the T-Shirts I prepared a bag with "try-on"-T-Shirts for the according artist(s), which I delivered with the fruit basket and the wristbands. The bag consisted of a T-Shirt of each size and colour and a list – they filled in the list and I took it back when I picked up the fruit basket. Then I prepared the bag with the requested T-Shirts and put a sticker with the according name on each and every T-Shirt.

Furthermore the 8:tension artists were given so-called "Jetons" (chips), which they could use to buy themselves drinks at the bar in the festival-lounge without having to actually pay for it. One chip was worth a drink like for example a small beer and in exchange of two they could enjoy a cocktail.

Now and then I also happened to be sent to buy requisites for some of the residencies or anything else that was needed. Whenever I bought something I was given companymoney and obviously had to cash it up afterwards. Depending on what I had bought I also delivered some of the things straight from there, for example to the rehearsing space.

Apart from that I assisted at the theatres in the evenings sometimes by giving out the guest & press tickets to the artist of the danceWEB activities.

Altogether it was an interesting experience and I had the chance of being able to sort of get an impression of what happens behind the scenes of Life Life Long Burning and the ImPulsTanz festival.
